- Ask the State Government to extend the definition of regulated smoke free areas to include additional places in order for there to be improved management of smoking in the CBD through State Legislation.

- Extend the deadline for public comment on the Burnie Heritage Project. Members of the public can view and comment on the project until 5pm Friday, June 18. The project reports are available at Council, the Burnie Library and the Pioneer Village Museum.
