## **Burnie Council Australia Day Award Guidelines and Criteria**

The following guidelines and criteria are used when considering the Citizen of the Year, Young Citizen of the Year, Senior Citizen of the Year and Community Event of the Year award nominations. All nominations received will be assessed against the following:

### **Guidelines for each award**

Awards aim to recognise citizens who have made a significant contribution to the City of Burnie and municipal area, through volunteer work or paid employment (in which case the contribution is significantly beyond what is normally expected without recompense or reward).

The nominee must reside in the Burnie municipality and be an Australian citizen.

**The nominee can only receive one Citizen / Young Citizen / Senior Citizen Award during their lifetime.**

The criteria regarding age shall be as set down by the Australia Day Council:

- Citizen Award
- Young Citizen Award – under 30 years of age
- Senior Citizen Award – over 65 years of age

### **Citizen, Young Citizen and Senior Citizen of the Year Awards**

*Consideration is given, but not limited to the following selection criteria:*

1. The impact of the person's contribution to a particular field, locality, group, community or humanity at large;
2. The period of time that the person has made a major commitment;
3. Whether the person's contribution has been recognised elsewhere (e.g. in the media, by other awards, interest groups or local councils);
4. The level of excellence that the person has demonstrated in their chosen field.

### **Community Event of the Year Award**

*Consideration is given, but not limited to the following selection criteria:*

1. The event must have been held in the Burnie and municipal area;
2. How did the event benefit the Burnie community, i.e. how the event "gave back";
3. How many hours were spent coordinating the event;
4. How many community volunteers assisted with organising and/or running the event;
5. What was the number of attendees at the event;
6. Where were the proceeds (if any) allocated;
7. What was the cost to enter the event.
