- Aerosols ■ Aluminium Cans ■ Asbestos
- Batteries & Radiators ■ Cardboard including Milk Cartons ■ Containers i.e. Chemical & Plastic Motor Oils ■ Clothing
- Concrete ■ Cooking oils ■ E-Waste
- Garbage ■ Gas Bottles ■ Glass products i.e. bottles & jars ■ Gravel ■ Green Waste
- Mattresses ■ Non – ferrous Aluminium, Copper, Brass ■ Plastic Bags ■ Plastic Bottles ■ Printer Cartridges ■ Steel
- Timber ■ Tyres ■ Waste Oils

The right way to sort your load.

- Determine what can be recycled and what is rubbish
- Keep the same materials grouped together
- Pack materials in the order that they'll be dropped off
- Secure your load with a net, ropes and/or straps.

When arriving at the Resource Recovery Centre, your load is checked to see what is being recycled and what is going to landfill. The more recyclables you have, the less you pay. Sort your load to save time, money and reduce waste going to landfill.

Now there's a good SORT!

S**TART** Before you leave home, neatly and securely pack your recyclables and waste.

Group the same types of materials together so it's easy to drop them in the different bays.

O**RGANISE** Pack your trailer or ute to match the order that you'll drop them off.

Refer to the map for the order that materials are dropped off as you move around the Waste Transfer Station bays.

R**ECYCLE** Separate your recyclables and waste. There are many materials that can now be recycled.

See what else you can recycle to reduce materials going into landfill.

T**HINK** By sorting your load, you'll save yourself time and money and be doing your bit for Tassie.

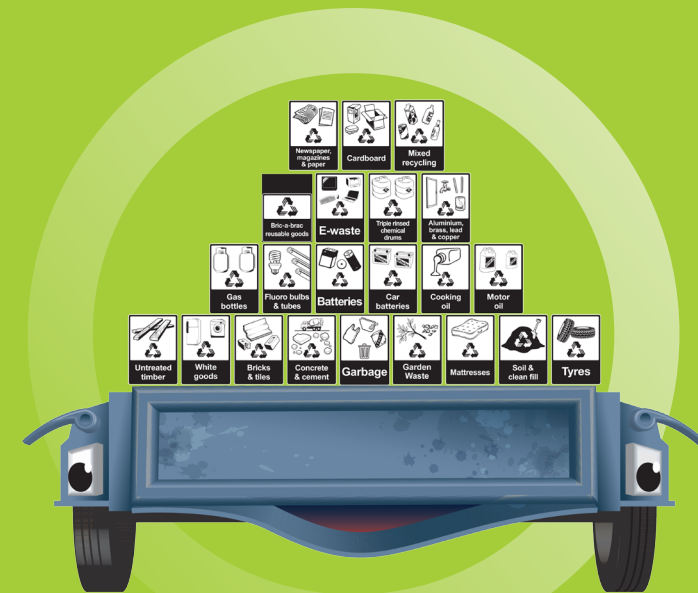

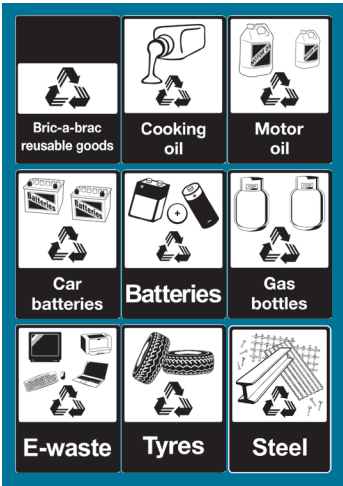
